

Corona Virus: Status Update of Gandaki Province

Kaski / April 16, 2020

The third covid-19 test report of 65 years old infected woman from Baglung has resulted in negative. Another test will be conducted after 24 hours and she will get discharged from Dhaulagiri hospital if another test report also results in negative.

According to the District Representative of Baglung, Srijana Panta, Rapid Diagnostic Test (RDT) was conducted on 13 people on Thursday. District Administration Office has kept 4 pedestrians who were going to Arghakhanchi, in a quarantine shelter of Shanti Samiti.

Dhorpatan Municipality went to peoples' homes to distribute social security allowances to 107 people including people with disability, senior citizens and single women.

According to the District Representative of Kaski, Sushan Ghimire, 96 people are staying in home quarantine. RDT reports of 382 people and swab tests of 123 people, both resulted in negative.

Human Rights Watch Group member Debilal Aryal has given 2,000 NPR to each of the 3 daily wage workers of Dang who were trying to reach their homes by walking from Pokhara.

According to the District Representative of Gorkha, Hariram Uprety, RDT reports of 40 people resulted in negative and as of now, RDT has been conducted on a total of 224 people.

According to the District Representative of Nawalparasi, Tirtharaj Dumre, RDT of 8 people and 5 peoples' swab sample test reports both resulted in negative.

According to the District Representative of Parbat, Santosh Thapa, RDT conducted on a total of 311 foreign returnees of the district resulted in negative. There are currently 10 people kept in quarantine. The workers of Baglung-Parbat Suspension Bridge project who were on their way home after the lock down have returned to Baglung after their food and accommodation was provided to them.

According to the District Representative of Tanahun, Prakash Chandra Bhattarai, as of today, RDT being conducted on 480 people resulted in negative. Local governments of the district have provided essential food supplies to more than 11,000 families in need.

According to the District Representative of Myagdi, Amrit Prasad Poudel, RDT report of 132 people resulted in negative and 6 people are kept in quarantine shelters.

According to the District Representative of Lamjung, Dal Bahadur Majhakoti, 45 people visited fever clinic on Thursday. There are 7 people staying in different quarantine shelters of district whereas 11 people have returned to home quarantine. RDT was conducted on 149 people and report of all test resulted in negative.

Beshisahar Municipality has decided to provide medicines to people who are currently under medication and ambulance services to the people who need to visit hospital regularly. Municipality also has been providing the essential food supplies to the people in need.
