

Corona Virus: Situation Update of Gandaki Province

Currently there are no new covid-19 infections reported in Gandaki province after 2 patients were discharged after treatment.

According to the District Representative of Baglung, Srijana Panta, while getting discharged from Dhaulagiri hospital after 28 days of treatment, 19 year old woman said that her self-strength, doctor's treatment, and her family's support and encouragement made her win the fight against corona virus. Rapid Diagnostic Test (RDT) of 4 people resulted in negative.

According to the District Representative of Kaski, Sushan Ghimire, with the initiation of Human Rights Monitoring Committee, 76 households of Squatter Community were provided essential relief packages by Pokhara metropolitan city. Madi rural municipality has been providing medicines to 56 people under regular medication. Lekhanath Chamber of Commerce has been providing foods for 1,200 working class and poor people every day since April 21.

According to the District Representative of Gorkha, Hariram Uprety, 4 people who had returned from Kathmandu and Chitwan were discharged from Himalaya School quarantine shelter after completing 14 days and their RDT tested in negative. The three Japanese tourists who came to Nepal before the lock down, were rescued from Manashlu Conservation Area and sent to Kathmandu on Sunday.

According to the District Representative of Nawalparasi, Tirtha Raj Dumre, RDT of 2 people have resulted in negative. Until Sunday, swab samples of 47 had been tested negative. Madhyabindu municipality has brought 82 stranded locals from Kathmandu and currently they are staying under home quarantine.

According to the District Representative of Parbat, Santosh Thapa, Chief District Officer (CDO) Kalpana Ghimire has requested to concerned people not to bring people from outside the district. Although District Administration Office has prohibited migration of people altogether, political party leaders are facilitating to bring people to Parbat from Kathmandu.

According to the District Representative of Tanahun, Prakash Chandra Bhattarai, until Sunday RDT had been conducted on 575 foreign returnees. RDT of 575 and swab sample test of 18 people have both resulted in negative. In the district 25 people are staying under quarantine including 10 Indian citizens.

According to the District Representative of Myagdi, Amrit Prasad Poudel, RDT of 154 and swab sample tests of 15 people resulted in negative. Currently 62 people are staying under quarantine in different quarantine shelters of local level. Due to the corona virus outbreak, residents of Mustang who had come down to valley to avoid the winter cold have not been able to enter their district. In Mustang quarantine shelter with the capacity of 90 beds and 10 isolation wards have been established. RDT on 34 people tested negative.

According to the District Representative of Lamjung, Dal Bahadur Majhakoti, currently 78 people are staying under quarantine shelters of the district. RDT of 33 tested negative.
