

Corona Virus: Situation Update of Province 5 Banke/ 30 April 2020

According to INSEC Dang District Representative Jayanarayan Pun, the detention has increased due to overcrowding in the custody of Division One Office. There are 17 people in custody with a capacity of six. Division Chief Deepak Gyawali said that the detainees and other forest workers were also at risk of corona virus due to overcrowding. Gyawali said that due to the risk of corona, the extension was being done through video conferencing from the detention center but the problem was aggravated when the court asked him not to appear before the court without examining the corona. District Court Judge Dhan Singh Giri said that the detainees could be released on certain bail to appear before the accused in cases other than serious ones. However, the District Forest Office could not implement the request.

According to INSEC Kapilvastu District Representative Parbati Acharya Chief of the District Health Office, Yogendra Bhagat, said that 14 people who had been in the quarantine of Krishnanagar for 14 days were sent to the National Laboratory in Kathmandu in collaboration with the District Health Office, Kapilvastu. The ward committee of Nepali Congress Wanganga Municipality-3 has distributed khul to Kapilvastu. Ward President Khimananda Pandey said that the distribution was made to 40 families including the poor, senior citizens and single people. Jailer Rakesh Pandey said that the Nepal Red Cross Society Kapilvastu branch office has handed over 150 soaps to the inmates of the district jail.

According to INSEC Gulmi District Representative Toplal Aryal, the local level has set up a relief fund for the prevention and control of corona in the district. Grants received from the state government, local level funds, remuneration provided by the people's representatives and employees, teachers and non-governmental organizations at the local level have contributed to the fund.

A relief fund of 11.5 million in ISMA rural municipality, 6.8 million in Dhurkot rural municipality relief fund, 6.0 million in Malika rural municipality, 5.5 million in Resunga municipality, 2.8 million in Musikot municipality, 3.1 million in Rurukshetra municipality, 4.0 million in Gulmi Darbar municipality, 2.3 million in Chhatrakot municipality and 19.25 million chandrakot municipality, Rs. 4 million in Satyavati and Rs. 2 million in Kaligandaki, were established.

According to INSEC Nawalparasi West District Representative Narayan Parajuli, 14-year-old boy, 65-year-old Purnamasi Kahar and 24-year-old Munna Kahar of Palhinandan Village Municipality-5 have been beaten and injured by the Armed Police Force. Is applied. The injured have been treated at Prithvichandra District Hospital. Among them, Purnamasi's head and hand were injured, while Akhilesh's arm was broken and Munna's chest and abdomen were injured, said Akhilesh Kabuwa Surendra Gaun. Similarly, Bardaghat Municipality has transferred Rs. 5 million to the Disaster Relief Fund. Funds have been collected in the fund from various organizations and individuals.

According to INSEC Rupendehi District Representative Reema BC, the Ministry of Land Management, Agriculture and Cooperatives of Province 5 has brought agro-workers employment program with the objective of encouraging those involved in

the agricultural sector. The state government expects the agriculture worker employment program to develop agriculture as an attractive sector by stopping the migrating labor force. For which, the state government has given priority to the private sector in the agro-employment program. As per the procedure approved by the state government from the Council of Ministers, now any agricultural firm, cooperative or institution has planned to provide employment to the people working in the agricultural sector by providing proper training and skills. the first phase, 30 percent of the cost will be borne by the state government and 70 percent by the employer company. Agricultural workers will get Rs. 10,781 as specified by the Government of Nepal. The Ministry of Land Management, Agriculture and Cooperatives of Province 5 has issued a press release on April 30. Spokesperson at the Ministry of Land Management, Agriculture and Cooperatives, Senior Agriculture Development Officer Vinod Ghimire said Discipleship. Ghimire said that the minimum standards required for the employment program to be done in collaboration with the private sector have also been prepared. Similarly, INSEC Rupendehi, in coordination and cooperation with the local levels, has distributed various materials to 12 persons with spinal cord injuries in the district.
