

Corona Virus: Situation Update of Sudurpaschim Province Kailali / 25 April 2020

According to the District Representative of Bajhang, Ramesh KC, a meeting of District Disaster Management Committee has decided to ensure data collection and one-door relief distribution system to provide essential food materials to the people in need and report the status of quarantine shelters in local level. The meeting also decided to mobilize ward chairperson leading volunteer teams and request federal and province government for 1,000 test kits.

According to the District Representative of Achham, Shivaraj Dhungana, Rapid Diagnostic Test (RDT) of 90 people has resulted in negative. Bayalpata Hospital director DR Bikash Gauchan has requested the farmers to maintain social distancing during the farming in field.

According to the District Representative of Darchula, Narendra Karki, 34 Nepalese migrant workers have crossed the Mahakali River to enter Darchula on Sunday despite the lock down. District Police Office Inspector Surendra Joshi has informed that coordination with Huti quarantine shelter is being carried out to keep them in quarantine. District Disaster Management Committee has requested to the government of Nepal to rescue more than 1,000 stranded people from India.

Mahakali corridor project that had been closed for a month due to the lock down is set to resume.

According to the District Representative of Baitadi, Nari Badu, Melauli and Surnaya municipality have been distributing social security allowances door to door. In order to maintain social distancing during corona virus outbreak, both local governments have initiated the door to door system to provide social security allowances.

According to the District Representative of Doti, Basudev Joshi, CDO Tek Narayan Poudel chaired meeting of District Disaster Management Committee meeting has decided to grant permission to resume development construction and industries by following the provisions passed by the 16th meeting of the High Level Coordination Committee for Corona Virus Prevention and Control. Relief monitoring committee has been monitoring relief distribution of the local governments.

According to the District Representative of Kailali, Mainamoti Chaudhary, the fourth test of covid-19 infected 34 year old woman has resulted in positive. She is under treatment in Seti Hospital's isolation ward. A total of 152 children have been vaccinated at the Seti Provincial Hospital on Sunday after the vaccination service was resumed. Twice a week, Monday and Friday children will get vaccinated in the hospital.

According to the District Representative of Bajura, Padam Bahadur Singh, in order to prevent corona virus spread, disinfection spray is being used in the villages of the district. The trained health workers have been carrying out the task of disinfection

spray in the hospitals, quarantine shelters and busy roads of 9 local governments. Jagganath rural municipality has been transporting food supplies to avoid food scarcity during the lock down.

According to the District Representative of Dadeldhura, Bhupendra Bista, 14 families of daily wage workers have been provided food materials. Former first vice president of Dadeldhura Chamber of Commerce, Bhojraj Bhatta has contributed to providing relief materials.

Amargadhi municipality has been facilitating to bring stranded students and working class people from Kathmandu, Kailali and Kanchanpur. Vehicles were sent on Sunday to bring them home.

According to the District Representative of Kanchanpur, Komal Niranjana Bhat, Bhimdatta municipality has provided sanitizers to squatter community people staying in Bhimdatta municipality-18 Sallaghari.
