

Corona Virus: Situation Update of Province One

Morang, 30 April, 2020

According to the District Representative of Morang, Netra Prasad Adhikari, currently 215 people have been staying in quarantine. In total 86,891 families in need were provided relief packages from all 17 local governments until Thursday. Biratnagar Nobel Medical College has taken a pregnant patient out of operating room for she was from one of the corona virus most affected districts, Udayapur.

According to the District Representative of Solukhumbu, Bhojraj Karki Necha Salyan rural municipality has provided relief packages to 19 families in need who are staying in Kathmandu currently. Solu Dudhkunda municipality has done the insurance of 82 staffs including health workers, staffs and security personnel who have been working during corona virus outbreak. Mahakulung rural municipality has monitored the situation of 65 rescued people who were stranded in outside districts.

According to the District Representative of Sankhuwasabha, Bhabin Karki, owner of Helping Hands community hospital Gupta Bahadur Shrestha and director of UWS Surya Karki have provided 4,34000 NPR worth health materials, to the district hospital.

According to the District Representative of Panchathar, Mangal Begha, RDT of 7 people have tested negative on Thursday and swab samples of 2 suspected people have been sent for PCR. In order to provide medicines to the people under regular medication, Crisis Management Center has formed a sub-committee in leadership of Health Office Chief.

According to the District Representative of Sunsari, Jayakrishna Yadav, Inaruwa municipality has decided to collect detail information of the households of all wards and 98 volunteers will be mobilized to collect the data. RDT of 35 people staying in Ramdhuni municipality quarantine shelter have resulted in negative and they have been sent home after the test. Social worker Shyam Kumari shah has provided 500 Kilogram of rice to provide for the people in need.

According to the District Representative of Ilam, Kokila Dhakal, during the market monitoring it has been found that traders have increased the price of vegetables and essential food materials. Social worker Dipak Kulung has contributed 30,000 NPR to Suryodaya municipality emergency fund and businessperson Pradip Kumar has contributed 21,000 NPR to Buddha Shanti rural municipality emergency fund.

According to the District Representative of Taplejung, Devraj Gurung, District Health Office was provided 400 RDT kits by provincial government on Thursday. Taplejung microfinance organization has provided 5 quintals of rice to Fungling municipality.

According to the District Representative of Jhapa, Naresh Khati, businessperson Naresh Khati, Krishna Kumar Giri and Ram Sitaula have provided essential food materials to the poor families of Arjundhara municipality-10. Budhabare

Jesis has organized blood donation program in order to mitigate blood shortage during the lockdown. Gorkha Shopping Complex of Chandragadhi has been charged 25,000 for committing black marketing.

According to the District Representative of Okhaldhunga, Shiva Prasad Dhungana, RDT of 229 and swab sample test of 11 people have resulted in negative. Meeting of District Crisis Management Centre and Command Post has decided to stop gatherings at religious and cultural practices. Khijidemba rural municipality has started providing health check up and social security allowances to senior citizens. Local governments of the district have been facilitating to bring their stranded people from Kathmandu.

According to the District Representative of Bhojpur, Ganesh Bista, after covid-19 detected on 26 year old man of Hatuwagadhi rural municipality, swab samples of 32 contacted people had sent for the test and all test reports resulted in negative.
